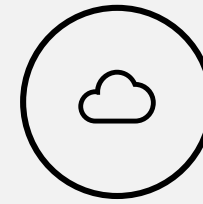
# Hybrid Protects Investments

# Skype for Business Server 2019 Changes

## Announced changes Skype for Business 2019 Server

- No Standard Edition, No Director Server, No PChat
- No Change to Survivable Branch Server
  - will use SfB 2015 Code-Base
- No further Response Group development
  - Office 365 Call Queue and AutoAttendant
- Current UCWA and UCMA solutions should continue to work. Maybe minor dependency updates (.NET, etc. )
- CCE can coexists but ideally move to SIP trunk connected to O365 (via Gateway)
- Hybrid Modern auth currently in preview
