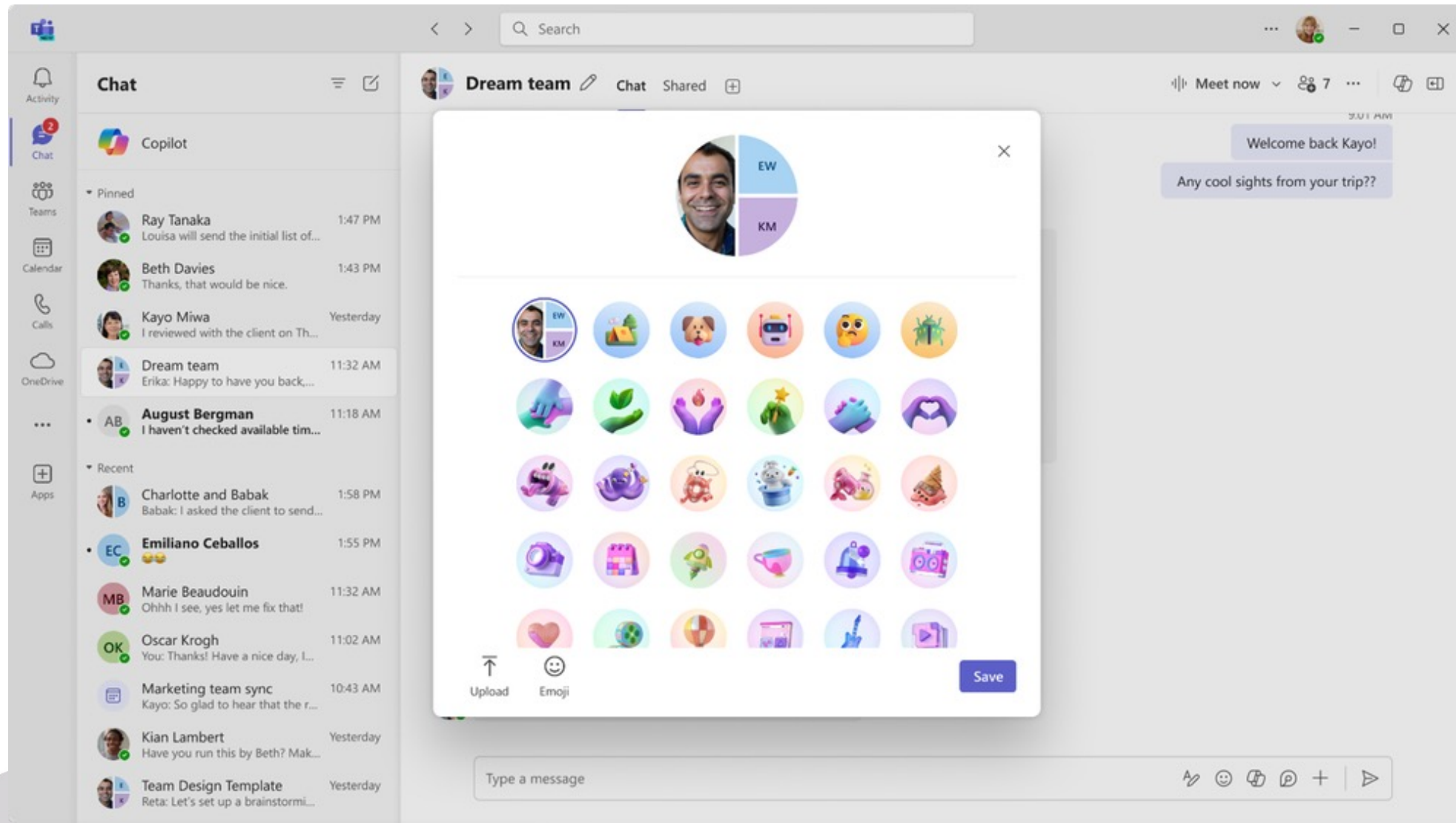

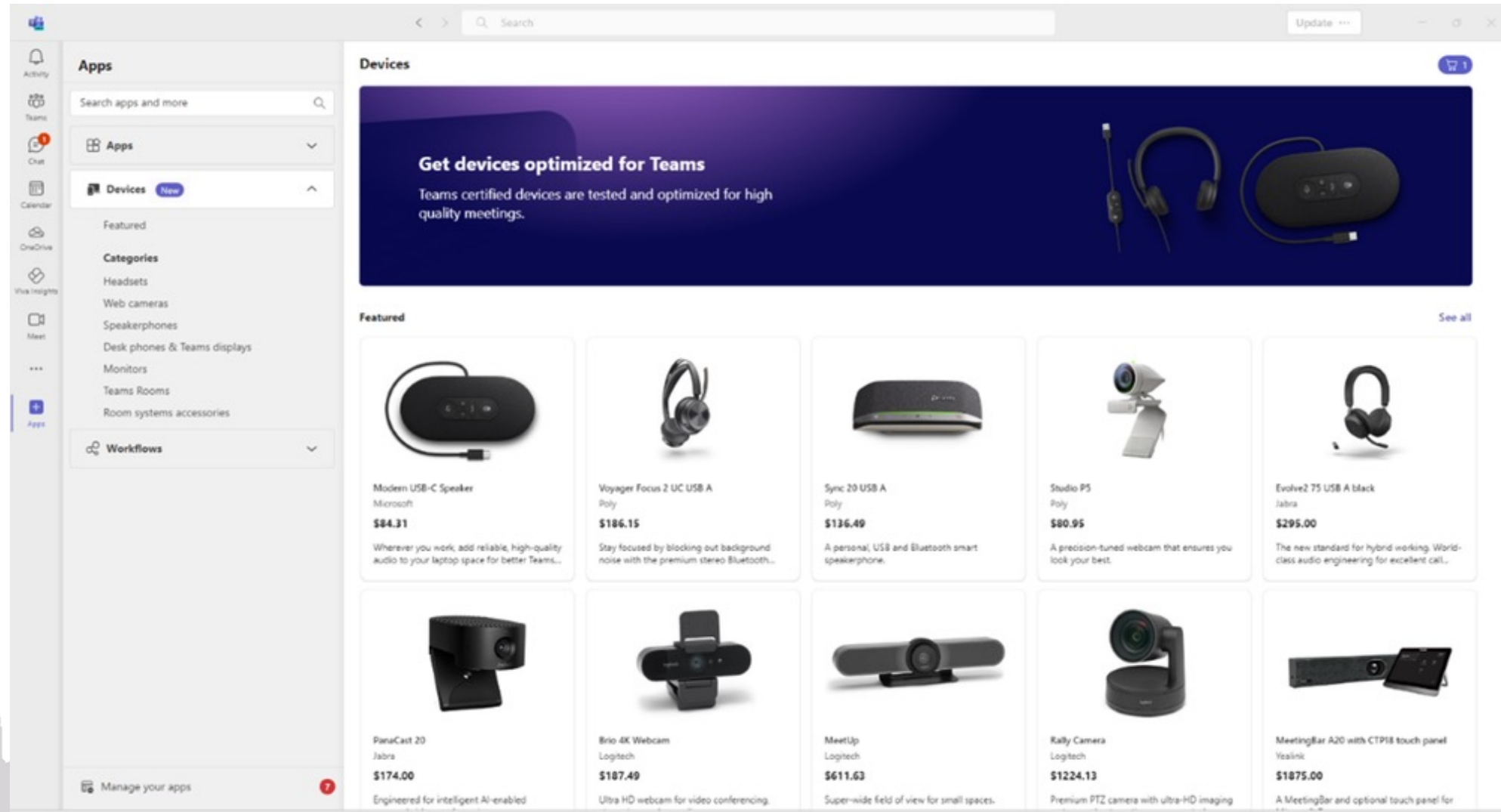

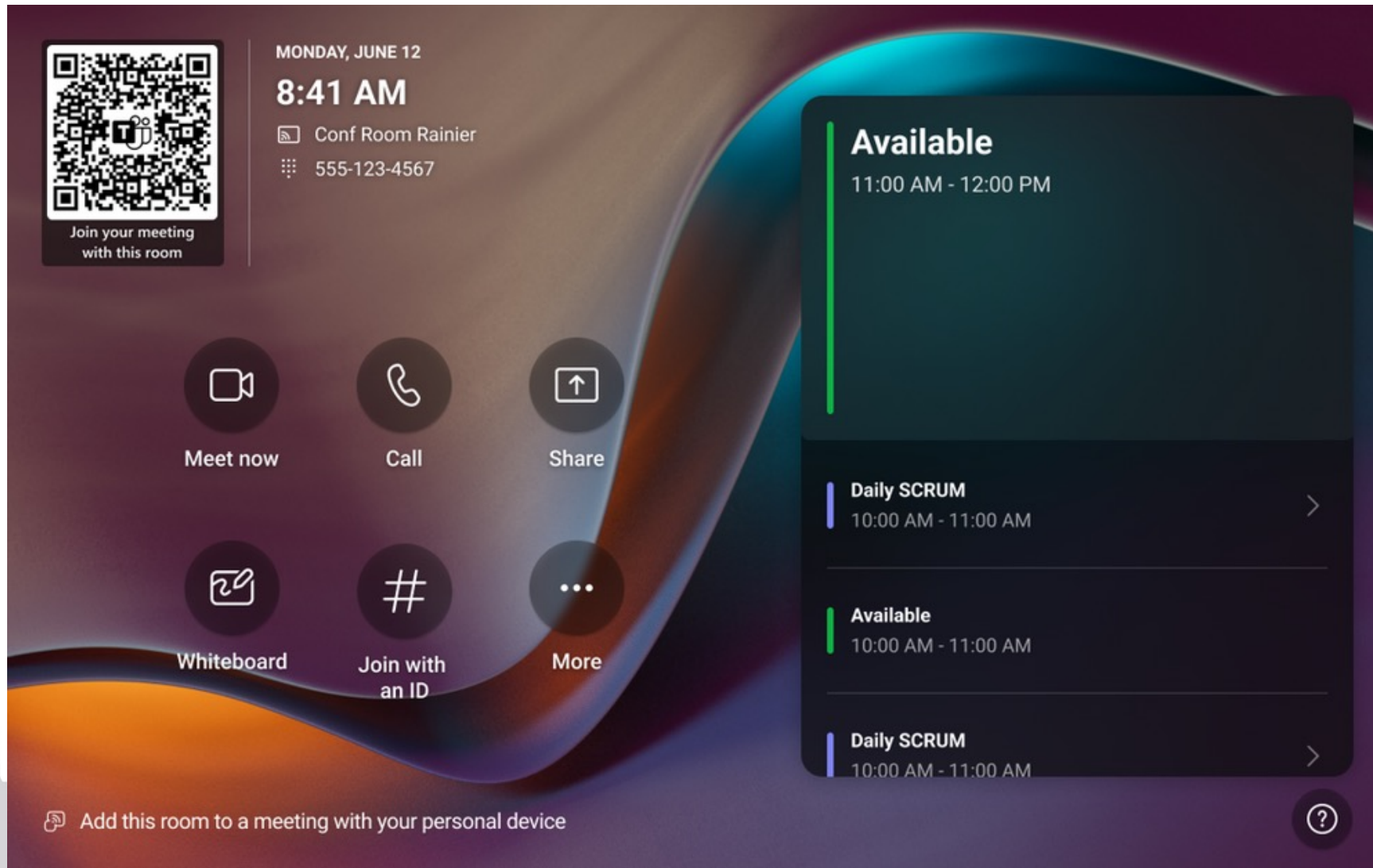

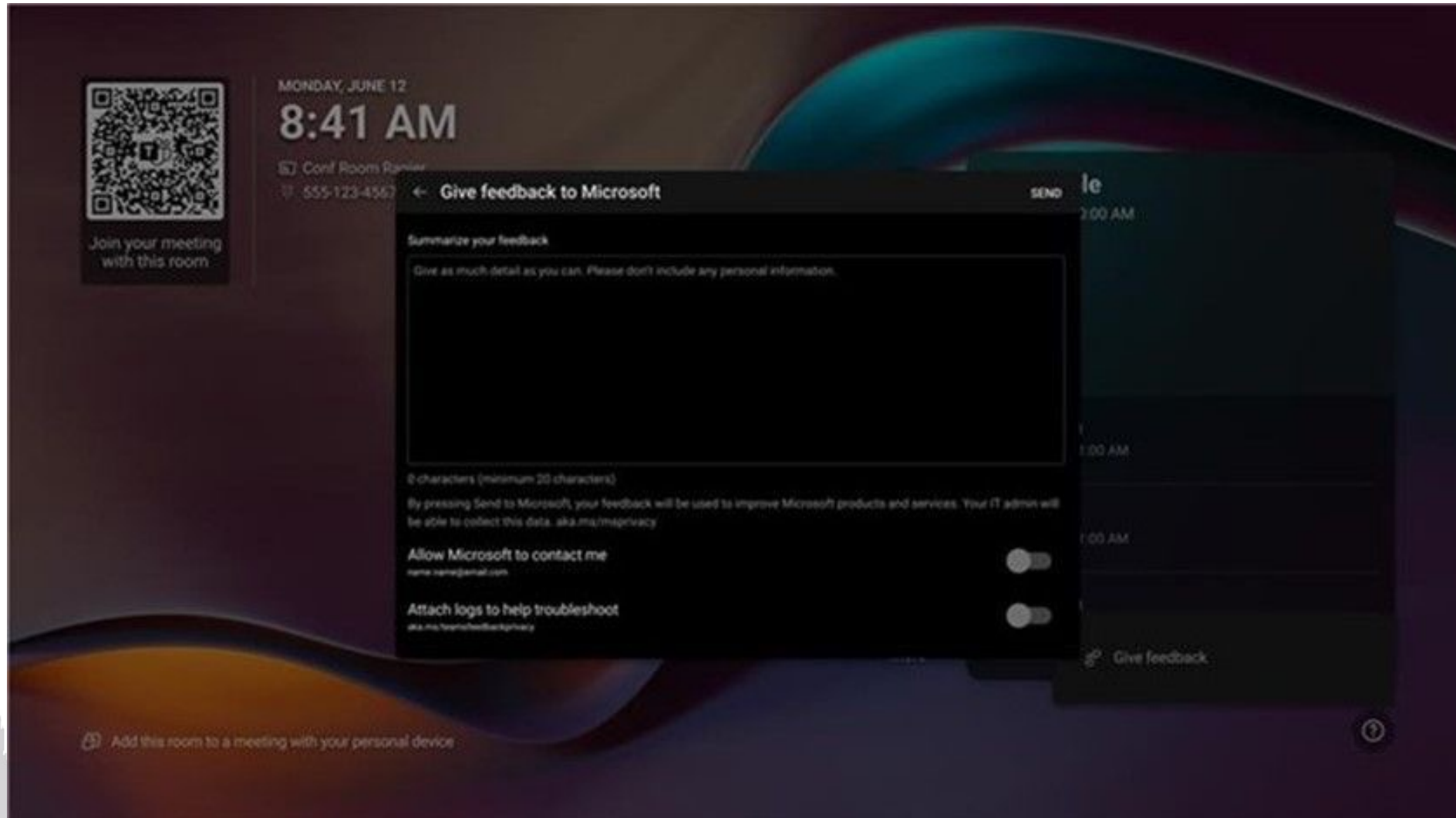



New task publishing features

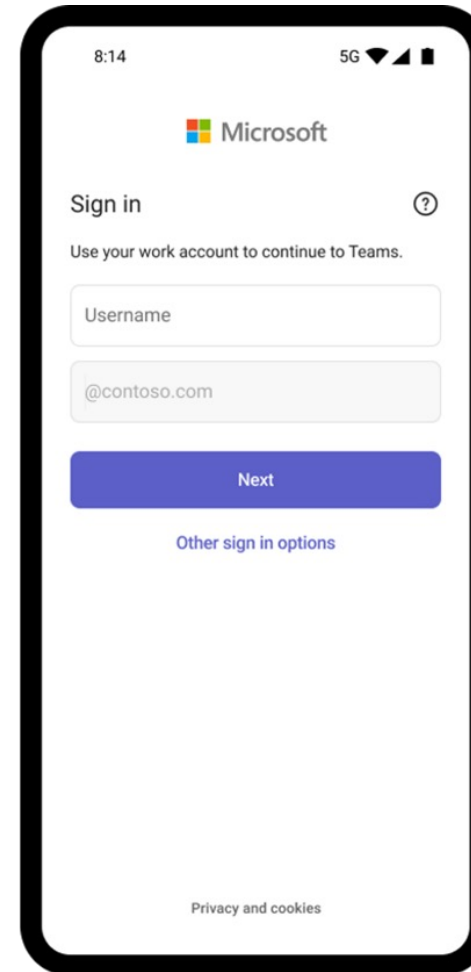
- Assign training and policy tasks to frontline employees (task list for each team member)
